## **Description:**

Elegant orchid flowers are mauve-purple with lighter lavender parts appearing on rising stalks over iris-like foliage; can be grown in the garden or in a container; keep roots well-drained, especially in winter

## **Features & Attributes**

Lavender Japanese Hyacinth Orchid features showy purple orchid-like flowers with lavender overtones rising above the foliage in late spring. Its attractive sword-like leaves remain green in color throughout the year.

This is an herbaceous houseplant with an upright spreading habit of growth. This plant may benefit from an occasional pruning to look its best.

## **Planting & Growing**

When grown indoors, Lavender Japanese Hyacinth Orchid can be expected to grow to be about 10 inches tall at maturity, with a spread of 12 inches. It grows at a medium rate, and under ideal conditions can be expected to live for approximately 10 years. This houseplant will do well in a location that gets either direct or indirect sunlight, although it will usually require a more brightly-lit environment than what artificial indoor lighting alone can provide. It does best in average to evenly moist soil, but will not tolerate standing water. The surface of the soil shouldn't be allowed to dry out completely, and so you should expect to water this plant once and possibly even twice each week. Be aware that your particular watering schedule may vary depending on its location in the room, the pot size, plant size and other conditions; if in doubt, ask one of our experts in the store for advice. It is not particular as to soil type or pH; an average potting soil should work just fine.
